# YARN

2 balls of AMEROSO from Rosários 4, color 21 - color A;

2 balls of AMEROSO from Rosários 4, color 22 - color B.

# **GAUGE**

22 sts and 25 garter ridges (50 rows) –  $10 \times 10$  cm in garter stitch with 3.5 mm needles, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch to get the correct gauge).

#### **NEEDLES**

3 mm circular needles with 80 cm cable (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

# **NOTIONS**

Tapestry needle, stitch marker, waste yarn, 3 small buttons.

# SIZE

0/1 months.

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

42 cm final bust and 23 cm height.

This cardigan is inspired by a pattern that was knitted a lot here in Portugal in the 50s and 60s. It reached me through the notes and memories of mothers and grandmothers who were knitters. This is why it's important for me to write this pattern down, which is also a way of preserving this heritage that embellishes so many baby photo albums. This cardigan is knitted sideways, starting at the left front and ending at the right front. It is knitted in short rows, using the two colors in stripes and alternating between garter and stockinette stitch. A fun construction that surprises with its simplicity. At the end, we finish with a small seam on each sleeve.

**Note:** when you change colors you should crossover the strands, always dropping the color you have just knitted over the color you are going to use.



# **LEFT FRONT**

With color A, long tail cast on 52 sts. Work the left front as follows:

Row 1 (RS): p to end.

Row 2 (WS): p2, yo, p2tog, [p5, yo, p2tog] x 2, p to end.

Row 3 (RS): p36, pm, p12, pm, p4.

Row 4 (WS): sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 5 (RS): p to marker, w+t.

Row 6: k to end.

Row 7: p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 8: change to color B, p to end.

Row 9: k to marker, w+t.

Row 10: p to end.

Row 11: k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

Repeat Rows 4 to 11 a further 6 times. The front should measure 12 cm from the beginning (at the widest part).

# **LEFT SLEEVE**

Work the sleeve as follows:

Row 1 (WS): sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 2 (RS): p to marker, w+t.

Cast on sts for the sleeve:

Row 3: k8, slip the next 28 sts to wste yarn and leave on hold; backward loop cast on 38 sts. There are 62 sts on the sleeve.

Row 4: p3, pm, p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

**Row 5:** change to color B, p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 6: sl1wyib, k to marker, w+t.

**Row 7:** p to 1 st before marker, turn.

**Row 8:** sl1wyib, k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

Row 9: sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 10: sl1wyif, p2, slm, p to marker, w+t.

Row 11: k to marker, slm, p3.

**Row 12:** sl1wyif, p2, slm, p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 13: change to color B, p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 14: sl1wyib, k to marker, w+t.

Row 15: p to 2 sts before marker, w+t.

Row 16: k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

Repeat Rows 9 to 16 another 9 times. The sleeve should measure 18 cm wide at the widest part.

Cast off the sleeve stitches and return the hold stitches:

Row 1 (WS): sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 2 (RS): bind off 38 sts and remove marker, p to marker, turn.

Row 3: k8, place the 28 sts on hold back on the lef-hand needle and knit. There are 52 sts on the needle.

Row 4: p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

AMEROSO

**Row 5:** change to color B, p to end.

Row 6: k to marker, w+t.

Row 7: p to end.

Row 8: k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

# **BACK**

Work the back as follows:

Row 1 (WS): sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 2 (RS): p to marker, w+t.

Row 3: k to end.

Row 4: p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 5: change to color B, p to end.

Row 6: k to marker, w+t.

Row 7: p to end.

**Row 8:** k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

Repeat Rows 1 to 8 another 13 times. The back should measure 22 cm wide at the widest part.

# **RIGHT SLEEVE**

Work the right sleeve in exactly the same way as the right sleeve, repeating the instruction.

#### **RIGHT FRONT**

Work the right front as follows:

Row 1 (WS): sl1wyif, p to end.

Row 2 (RS): p to marker, w+t.

Row 3: k to end.

**Row 4:** p to marker, slm, p to marker, turn.

Row 5: change to color B, p to end.

Row 6: k to marker, w+t.

Row 7: p to end.

**Row 8:** k to marker, slm, p to marker, slm, change to color A and p to end.

Repeat Rows 1 to 8 another 5 times.

Cut color B and continue with color A. Work in garter stitch:

Rows 1 to 3: p to end.

Bind off all sts.

# **FINISHING**

Sew the sleeves - close the sleeve by sewing the side selvedges with mattress stitch from the right side of the fabricl. Start sewing at the cuff and work your way up along the sleeve selvedges to the armhole. Sew on the buttons on the right front, opposite each of the buttonholes on the left front. Weave in all ends with a tapestry needle. Wash carefully with mild soap. Block garment to final measurements.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

K knit

P: purl

cm: centimeters

st/sts stitch/ stitches

**RS** right side

**WS** wrong side

**pm** place marker

slm slip marker

**sl1wyif** slip 1 st purlwise and with the yarn in front of the work

**sl1wyib** slip 1 st purlwise and with the yarn in the back of the work

yo yarn over

p2tog purl 2 stitches together

Wrap and turn short rows:

w+t wrap and turn

When knitting knit to the turning point, slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front and

bring yarn to the front of work, in between the needles; return the slipped stitch back to the left-hand needle, turn the work, bring yarn to the front

in between the needles and purl.

When purling purl to the turning point, slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front and bring yarn to the back of the work, in between the needles; return the slipped

stitch back to the left-hand needle, turn the work, bring yarn to the back in between the needles and knit.

On the following rows, whenever you find a wrapped stitch, work as usual (without picking up the wrap).
